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KARAMJIT SINGH, J.

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking grant of anticipatory bail in criminal case having FIR No. 151 dated 30.06.2023, registered under Sections 307, 323, 341, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Division No.5, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.
2. The counsel for the petitioner submits that no specific injury is attributed to the petitioner, who has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of the previous order.
3. The State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmej Lal submits that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and that as per FIR there are no specific allegations against the petitioner.
4. In light of the above, as the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police, no purpose will be served even if the petitioner is subjected to custodial interrogation at this point of time.

5. Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 04.12.2023 is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions specified in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and should join further investigation as and when asked to do so by the police.
