1. Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to fix pay of the petitioner in the pay scale of Rs.5200-20200+3200/- GP w.e.f. 01.02.2006 in view of instructions dated 23.08.2014 (Annexure P-6)

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the aforesaid benefit, petitioner has served legal notice dated 15.05.2024 (Annexure P-9) upon the respondents, however, the pay of the petitioner has been fixed as above nor the said legal notice has been replied to by the respondents. Learned counsel submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said legal notice is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondent No.3 is directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in legal notice dated 15.05.2024 (Annexure P-9) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. The petition stands disposed of.
