By way of present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, a prayer has been made for issuance of direction to official respondent Nos. 2, 3 & 6 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his parents at the hands of respondent Nos. 6 to 9.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representation dated 31.07.2023 (P-1) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

[3] Mr. State Counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent Nos. 6 to 9, raise no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

[4] In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this petition is **disposed off** with a

direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the representation dated 31.07.2023 (P-1) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of six (06) weeks from today.
