LISA GILL, J.

1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing action of respondent Nos.1 and 2 whereby they are attempting to forcibly recover petitioner's truck bearing registration No.PB-13-BG-8344 with the help of Recovery Agent.
2. Learned counsel for respondent – Bank submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as petitioner's account has been settled and closed.
3. There was a written request circulated on behalf of petitioner on the last date. Today there is no representation on behalf of petitioner. However, in view of categorical statement made by learned counsel for respondent -Bank, we find no justification for continuation of present proceedings.

4. Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous. In case, any incorrect fact has been placed before us, petitioner is at liberty to file appropriate application within four weeks.
