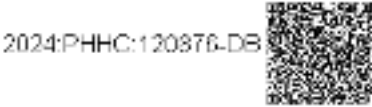

We had heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length on 12.09.2024. However, pursuant to the request made by learned State counsel, the matter was adjourned for today, to enable him to seek instructions.

Today, during the course of hearing and considering the issue that arises for determination, we had requested the learned Advocate General, Punjab, to intervene in the matter. Accordingly, he assisted the Court and, on instructions from the competent authority, submits that the dispute between the parties would be resolved and necessary orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed, within a week from today.

Likewise, learned counsel for the respondent-Trust, on instructions from Mr. Harpreet Sandhu, Estate Officer, also fairly



submits, for the matter is already under active consideration of the Trust, a formal decision to redress the grievances of the petitioner would be reached in the immediate future, which shall be communicated to him.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let the petition be disposed of, in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the respondents. However, if any further cause of action or dispute still arises, the petitioner shall avail such other remedies, as admissible in law, including filing a fresh petition.
