HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

Present criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioners praying for protection to their life and liberty, in view of the marriage solemnized by them against the wishes of respondent Nos. 4 to 6.

[2] Paper-book reveals that marriage of petitioner Nos. 1 & 2 was solemnized on 11.09.2023. The documents annexed by the petitioners with the petition including their Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) show that both are major and duly identified by their counsel, but apprehending danger to their life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 6.

[3] Upon notice, learned State Counsel has filed a short reply by way of affidavit dated 12.02.2024 of Sh. Arvind Kamboj, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Crime, Panchkula, which is taken on record. Copy thereof be supplied to the opposite side.

[4] In the aforesaid reply / affidavit dated 12.02.2024, the statements of family members of the petitioners have been recorded, which

are annexed as Annexures R-3 to R-5, according to which, there is no threat perception to the petitioners; thus, learned State Counsel submits that present petition may be dismissed.

[5] In view of the aforesaid reply, no further cause survives in the present petition and the same is **disposed off** as such. However, it is clarified that in case any threat perception is expressed by the petitioners, they would be at liberty to seek their remedy as per law before the authorities concerned.

[6] Pending miscellaneous applications(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
