1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.78 dated 26.07.2024, under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 299, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, registered at Police Station Raikot, District Ludhiana.
2. Vide order dated 10.09.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 10.09.2024, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhveer Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.
5. In view of the above, interim order dated 10.09.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
6. Petition stands allowed.
