AMARJOT BHATTI, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioner Jaswant Singh Bharta has filed petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India, praying for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing official respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of petitioner from the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 6, who are threatening to eliminate present petitioner or to involve him in a false case.

2. In pursuance of this petition, learned counsel representing official respondents No. 2 and 3 has filed detailed status report and finally in para No. 15, it is observed that there is no apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of petitioner or his family. However, petitioner has been provided contact number of SHO and MHC of Police Station City Nawanshahar and he is free to call at any time to them in case of any exigency and he is free to approach any of the police official of District SBS Nagar in the event of any apprehension to his life and liberty.

Considering the aforesaid factual position, grievance of present petitioner is addressed by official respondents No. 2 and 3. Present petition has rendered infructuous.

3. In view of status report as detailed in para No. 15, present petitioner is free to approach official respondents No. 2 and 3, in case of any threat perception and official respondents will take appropriate steps in this regard.

4. With this observation, present petition is accordingly, disposed of.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
