1. This appeal has been filed by appellants, who are arrayed as respondents No.5, 7, 8 and 12 in CWP-2519-2012 for challenging interim order dated 06.11.2017 passed in CM-12078-CWP-2016 in CWP-2519-2012. The said application was filed by respondent-college under Section

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151 CPC seeking appropriate orders in CM-6924-CWP-2013 in the said writ petition wherein prayer is for stay of operation of order dated 17.11.2011 impugned in the writ petition.

2. Vide impugned order dated 06.11.2017, passed by learned Single Bench, it was directed that any further payments of equivalent pay scales to the private respondents shall remain stayed. Present appeal was accordingly filed challenging the same.

3. Notice of motion was issued in this appeal on 07.12.2017 and operation of impugned order dated 06.11.2017 was stayed.

4. It is informed by learned counsel for the parties that the writ petition was admitted on 11.11.2013 with the direction that writ petition be set down for hearing within three months. In LPA-1461-2015 arising out of the same litigation, it has been directed that the writ petition be set down for hearing after obtaining orders from Hon'ble the then Acting Chief Justice with liberty to the parties to make a prayer for expeditious disposal. It is further informed that as of now the matter is listed for regular hearing before learned Single Bench of this Court.

5. It is expressed that all the parties are interested in expeditious disposal of the matter, hence it is agreed that appropriate application shall be filed by the present appellant for hearing and final disposal of the writ petition on an actual date and that none of the counsel shall seek any adjournment whatsoever and arguments shall be addressed as may be permitted by learned Single Bench.

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6. In view of above, this appeal is disposed of accordingly with liberty to the appellant to file an appropriate application before learned Single Bench for final disposal of the writ petition. Interim order dated 07.12.2017 shall enure.
