1. Challenge in the present revision petition is to the order dated 12.10.2022 passed by the Rent Controller-cum-Civil Judge (Senior Divn.), Rewari vide which an application filed under Section 151 read with Section 144 CPC for restitution of the possession has been dismissed.

2. It would be relevant to note that this Court, vide order of an even date, has dismissed the revision petition filed by the petitioner i.e. Civil Revision No.2098 of 2021 and thus, the interim order passed in the said revision petition has merged with the final judgment dismissing the revision petition, and thus, the present petition, which is for challenging the order vide which the restitution has been rejected, has been rendered infructuous and be disposed of as such.

3. In view of the above, present Civil Revision Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
