1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.100 dated 26.08.2024 under Sections 115(2), 190, 191(3), 351(2), 324(4) of BNS, 2023 (Section 118(2), 331(7) of BNS were added and Sections 333, 118(1) BNS were deleted lateron), registered at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka.

2. The matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and as per the report of the Mediator, it transpires that though on some occasions the parties have appeared, however, thereafter the complainant did not appear and thus, the mediation could not take place further.

3. Vide order dated 11.09.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 11.09.2024 petitioner has joined the investigation

and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.



5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.
6. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
7. In view of the above, interim order dated 11.09.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
8. Petition stands allowed.
