1. Petitioner Vivek Singla has filed anticipatory bail petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in complaint case No. COMA-85-2022 dated 14.09.2022, under Section 32 read with Section 17(c), 18(a)(I), 18(a)(vi), 18(c), 22(1)(cca) read with Section 27(D), 28A, 36AC of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940, Annexure P-1.

2. As per previous order dated 12.09.2024, petitioner was directed to surrender before learned trial Court within 10 days and be released on *interim* bail to the satisfaction of said Court.

3. Learned counsel appearing for petitioner stated that in compliance of aforesaid order, petitioner has already surrendered before learned trial Court and he is appearing on each and every date of hearing.

4. Learned Senior Panel Counsel appearing for Union of India further confirmed this fact.

5. In view of aforesaid factual position, *interim* bail already granted to petitioner vide order dated 12.09.2024 stands confirmed, subject to the same terms and conditions.

6. Petition is accordingly, allowed.

7. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of accordingly.
