1. Present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 05.04.2022 (Annexure P-5) passed by Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana, in Civil Suit bearing CS No.4490, titled as 'Mohan Singh Vs. Ranjit Kaur', vide which, application of respondent/plaintiff under Section 65 of the Indian Evidence Act for leading secondary evidence of agreement dated 03.12.2015 has been allowed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since in the impugned order it has been mentioned that the application has been allowed subject to the condition that the existence of the original and handing over the same to defendant is to be established by leading secondary evidence, thus, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present revision petition with liberty to raise all points including all objections which are available to her in law during the course of trial.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
