1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No. 90 dated 24.04.2024, under Sections 120-B, 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Panipat City, District Panipat.
2. On the last date of hearing, the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation with the police. Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner made statement that by virtue of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined investigation with the police.
3. The State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajesh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the petitioner and further submits that petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation. It is apparent that the present petitioner was not signatory to the sale deed in question.

4. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 09.09.2024 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner is to be abide by the conditions as are provided under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.
