1. By way of present petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent on account of alleged willful disobedience of order dated 15.07.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-15958-2024.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent informs this Court that in terms of the interim order granted vide order dated 15.07.2024, the relieving order of the petitioner has been withdrawn by the competent authority vide order dated 09.09.2024 and she shall be taken back in service within a period of one week from today.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

4. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not

pressed.

5. However, in case the needful is not done within the
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at
liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the
erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.1 lakh
as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards
litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival
application.

6. Rule stands discharged.
