furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of*

Arresting/Investigating Officer. She shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

2. Today, on instructions from SI Jitender Kaur, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 06.12.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

3. In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 06.12.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, she shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
