HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that a fresh speaking order shall be passed after hearing the petitioners, within a period of two weeks from today and speaking order shall be conveyed to the petitioners within a week thereafter.
2. In view thereof, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of. Rule stands discharged.
- However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
