1. Petitioner Neelam has filed criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ, order or direction specially in the nature of Mandamus, directing respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect life and liberty of petitioner and property from the hands of private respondents No. 5 to 9 and with further direction to dispose of her representation dated 22.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) and legal notice dated 29.08.2024 (Annexure P-6) filed by petitioner or any other relief which the Court may deem fit and proper in the given facts and circumstances of case.
2. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that civil litigation is going on with private respondents No. 5 to 9. However, present petitioner is not party to said civil litigation. There is no criminal litigation going on. Respondents No. 5 to 9 are extending threats to life and liberty of petitioner as well as her property.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State. Advance copy of petition supplied to learned State counsel along with aforesaid representation. It is stated that representation dated 22.08.2024, Annexure P-5 and legal notice dated 29.08.2024, Annexure P-6 will be disposed of by the concerned office within two weeks.
5. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, present criminal writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to dispose of representation dated 22.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) and legal notice dated 29.08.2024 (Annexure P-6) filed by petitioner, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in the meantime, in case there is any threat perception, then appropriate steps be taken to secure life and liberty of petitioner.
6. Writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
