The limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is that against an order dated 29.01.2021 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurugram, declining the prayer to register the FIR under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C. on the complaint moved by the petitioner, the petitioner had filed criminal revision bearing No.CRR-24-2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention towards various zimni orders to contend that though the service of the respondent was complete at least on 23.03.2022, but the matter is being adjourned time and again only for the purpose of arguments. Learned counsel prays to direct the Court concerned to dispose of the revision filed by the petitioner.
