The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to the learned trial Court to serve at least 10 days notice before making any order of arrest in the event of framing of charge under Section 302 of IPC instead of Section 304-B of IPC as the prosecution has filed an application dated 02.08.2024 (Annexure P-11) under Section 216 of Cr.P.C. to amend the charges and frame the charge under Section 302 of IPC along with alternative charges already framed in case bearing FIR No.133 dated 02.12.2018 under Section 304-B of IPC registered at Police Station City-II, Abohar District Fazilka (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage with liberty to file fresh petition if the cause of action arises.
