1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing of action of respondent Nos.1 to 3, whereby the reference under Section 30 filed by respondent No.4 has been referred to the Reference Court for adjudicating/appropriation of the amount of compensation awarded by the Land Acquisition Collector, Gurugram, vide award dated 21.01.2020.

2. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that a reference has already been made to the competent Court, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere in the matter.

3. Dismissed.

4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to raise all the legally available pleas to it, before the Reference Court, at the appropriate stage.
