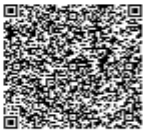

The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members.

2. Status report by way of an affidavit dated 18.10.2024 of Sh. Maninder Pal Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Amritsar has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. In the status report, the following has been stated :-

“3. That it is submitted that the deponent is filing the present status report based on the report obtained from SHO PS Sadar, Amritsar with regard to the progress made during investigation of the case FIR No. 187 dated 19.08.2024, under Section 125, 3 (5), 351 (1) BNS, 25 Arms Act, Police Station Sadar, Amritsar and efforts made for safety and security of the petitioner and his family members



in order to protect their life and liberty.

4. That it is submitted that as per the report furnished by SHO PS Sadar, Amritsar, during investigation of the aforesaid case FIR No. 187 dated 19.08.2024 (supra), sincere efforts are being made to trace out the culprits for which suspected persons have been associated in investigation and help of esteemed persons of the locality but no clue of the accused persons has so far been found. However, sincere and possible efforts are being made to trace out the actual culprits and this case is under investigation. The deponent has issued appropriate directions to SHO P.S. Sadar, Amritsar to carry out investigation of this case in a fair and impartial manner and to make more strenuous efforts to trace out the actual culprits.

5. That it is further submitted that one gunman namely LR/ASI Jaswant Singh No. 1741/ASR-City having one carbine, 2 magazines and 35 cartridges has been deployed with the present petitioner on 23.09.2024 for safety and security of the petitioner and his family members in order to protect their life and liberty. In addition to this, the protection of the petitioner and his family members is also being covered through area security.”

3. In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
