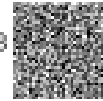

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was working as Baildar with the respondent-University but his services have been terminated by the respondent-University on the ground that no work of the said post exists whereas, even as of now, said post Baildar is still existed with the respondent-University and work of the said post also exists in the other departments of the respondent-University and hence, the respondent-University is under an obligation to adjust the petitioner against the available post of Baildar in the other departments of the respondent-University.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Gagandeep Singh Virk, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent-University and submits that in case, any claim is raised by the petitioner that the post of Baildar is still vacant in



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other departments of the respondent-University where the petitioner can be adjusted, the said claim will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such claim and in case, it is found feasible, the relief will be extended to petitioner otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner as well for his information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent-University, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
