1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking quashing of order dated 19.02.2024 passed by the Court of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kalka vide which the bail bonds of the petitioner were cancelled and he was directed to be summoned through non bailable warrants in criminal case having FIR No.637 dated 20.11.2022, under Sections 279, 304-A, 337, 427 IPC at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula, on account of his absence before the learned trial Court.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was regularly appearing before the trial Court but due to some emergent situation, he failed to appear before the trial Court on 19.02.2024 and resultantly, the impugned order was passed by the trial Court. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is ready and willing to join proceedings before the trial Court at the earliest and will also assure that in future he will remain careful.

3. Notice of motion.



4. Ms. Harpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from ASI Mahipal submits that absence of the petitioner on 19.02.2024 was intentional as key witness Sahil Bansal was present in the Court on that date and in order to avoid recording of the statement of the said witness, the petitioner got absented.

5. Admittedly, all the offences are bailable offences and this was single default on the part of the petitioner.

6. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in order to avoid any further delay in trial, the petitioner is hereby directed to join proceedings before the trial Court within next 10 days and on his doing so, the petitioner is to be released on regular bail by the Court concerned to its own satisfaction and subject to cost of Rs.10000/- to be deposited by the petitioner with the District Legal Services Authority concerned.

6. Disposed of in aforesaid terms.
