1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 26.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) as well as the order dated 25.08.2023 (Annexure P-12) passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Ludhiana vide which the application under Order VII Rule 11 CPC filed by the respondent-defendant has been allowed.
2. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that vide judgment dated 02.04.2024, the main case itself has been decided in view of the compromise between the parties and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. In view of the above, present Civil Revision Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
