By way of present petition filed under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 29.04.2024 (**Annexure P-2**) passed by this Court in CWP No. 3741 of 2017, the relevant portion thereof reads as under:-

“ Under the given circumstances, the impugned orders are set aside. The petitioners are held entitled to interest @ 6% per annum from 01.03.2005 till actual disbursement of the amount in favour of the petitioners. Let the interest @ 6% per annum be released in favour of the petitioners within a period of 03 months after the receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case the amount is not released within the period of three months as above, the petitioners shall be entitled to further interest @ 9% per annum after expiry of three months. ”

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that mandate form handed over in the Court by the learned counsel for the respondents shall be furnished to them within a period of two days from today.

[3] In response, learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, submits that the requisite payment shall be made within a period of two weeks from today.

[4] In view of the aforesaid stand / undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition any further.

[5] Dismissed as not pressed.

[6] However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail remedy, as per law, in case any cause still survives.

[7] Rule stands discharged.
