The prayer in the present petition under Section 483 of BNSS read with Section 528 BNSS, 2023 is for the grant of interim bail to the petitioner for four weeks on the medical ground of the petitioner’s wife in FIR No.158 dated 14.06.2023 registered under Sections 15(c) NDPS Act (Sections 29, 21(c) of NDPS Act, Sections 25(6), 25(7) of Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 307, 323, 186, 332, 353 IPC) at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh submits that the wife of the petitioner was subjected to medical examination by a Board of Doctors and was thereafter referred to PGIMER, Chandigarh. However, instead of appearing before the said Hospital, the wife of the petitioner sought treatment from a private hospital.

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In view of the conduct of the petitioner and his wife, I find
no merit in the present petition. Therefore, the same stands dismissed.
