1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.68 dated 01.07.2023, under Sections 307, 379, 506, 295-A, 447, 511, 323, 120-B, 148, 149, 427 IPC and Sections 25, 27 and 54 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Dehlon, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.
2. Vide order dated 09.09.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 09.09.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
5. In view of the above, interim order dated 09.09.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
6. Petition stands allowed.
