Main case

1. Learned counsel for the appellant has informed that initially a cancellation report was prepared on 06.04.2023, wherein it was stated that allegations levelled against the appellant were found to be false during the investigation. On 21.04.2023, the Additional Director General of Police, Hisar Range, Hisar directed re-investigation of the case and thereafter again report dated



24.06.2023 was prepared wherein the allegations against the appellant were found to be false.

- 2. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that now cancellation report has been presented before the trial Court on 11.03.2024 and notice to the complainant has also been issued.
- 3. Learned State counsel has informed that in view of the cancellation report having been submitted before the trial Court, the appellant is not required in the present case.
- 4. Faced with this, learned counsel for the appellant seeks to withdraw the present appeal at this stage as having been rendered infructuous.
- 5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
- 6. All pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
