The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.33 dated 10.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Section 283 of IPC and Section 8-B of National Highway Act, 1956 registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda as well as consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

At the very outset, the learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Resham Singh, submits that the Investigating Agency has already concluded the investigation and has recommended the cancellation of FIR (*supra*). The cancellation report has already been filed before the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate on 12.02.2024 and submits that the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, the grievance of petitioner has been substantially redressed, as such, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
