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**KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)**

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.112 dated 01.05.2021 registered under Sections 323, 325, 452, 379, 148, 149, 506 of IPC at Police Station City Kapurthala District Kapurthala.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that matter has been compromised between the parties and further petitioner has joined investigation with the police in compliance of the earlier order dated 09.12.2022.
3. State counsel on instructions from SI Rakesh Kumar submits that petitioner has joined investigation with the police and is not required by the police for further investigation.
4. Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 has not disputed the fact that matter stands compromised between the parties and

he is having no objection if the present petition is allowed and anticipatory bail is granted to the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 09.12.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
