CRM-4619-2024

1. Application for exemption is allowed, as prayed for.

CRM-4623-2024

1. By this application, the applicants-petitioners seek permission to place on record copies of the orders dated 27.10.2022 and 08.01.2024, passed by the learned trial Court as Annexures P-16 and P-17 with the accompanying petition.

2. The application is allowed and the aforesaid copies of the orders passed by the learned trial Court are ordered to be taken on record as Annexures P-16 and P-17 subject to all just exceptions with the accompanying petition. Office to tag the same at appropriate place.

CRM-4624-2024

1. By this application, the applicants-petitioners seek disposal of the main petition as all the petitioners have surrendered before the learned trial Court, in compliance of the order dated 21.10.2022 passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

2. For the reasons mentioned in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit of petitioner No. 1, the application is allowed and the main petition which is otherwise fixed for 14.03.2024 is taken up on Board today itself.

CRM-M-49267-2022 (O&M)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the order dated 04.08.2022 (Annexure P-12), passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridkot, whereby non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued against the petitioners in FIR No. 202, dated 07.11.2019, under Sections 363, 366, 376, 342 and 506 of the IPC read with Section 34 thereof, registered at Police Station City Kotakpura, District Faridkot.

2. Counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that the petitioners had been continuously appearing after the '*challan*' was presented before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot, on 08.01.2022. However, due to wrong noting down of the date of appearance on 31.05.2022, the petitioners could not appear before the trial Court on 04.08.2022.

3. He further contends that in compliance of the order dated 21.10.2022, the petitioners are regularly appearing before the learned trial Court.

4. Learned State counsel on instructions from the police official who is present in Court today to assist her has confirmed the fact that the petitioners are regularly appearing before the learned trial Court.
5. In view of the aforesaid circumstances, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 21.10.2022 passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute.
6. Resultantly, the impugned order dated 04.08.2022 (Annexure P-12), passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridkot, is set aside.
7. Pending miscellaneous application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
