1. The petitioner in the instant (third) petition is seeking the concession of bail under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.197 dated 22.07.2020 under Section 302 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Parao, District Ambala.
2. Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant have at the outset informed the Court that the trial is at the fag end and even arguments have been advanced by the learned counsel for the parties; the case is now fixed for final orders for 23.02.2024.
