1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 12 and 15 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 02.11.2019 passed in TA-383-2019.
2. Since the petitioner is having the remedy of execution, therefore, this Court does not find it appropriate to initiate contempt proceedings against the respondent, as such. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
3. However, the petitioner would be liberty to avail the alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
