By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS,
2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR as under: -

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 16.10.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. During the course of hearing on 16.10.2024, following order had been passed: -

“ *Heard.*

It is inter alia contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that on account of stray cattles entering



into the fields, an altercation took place between the parties, but no specific overt act is attributed to the petitioner. He contends that the alleged injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature and the petitioner himself sustained 4 injuries on his person. He further submits that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedents and is ready to join investigation.

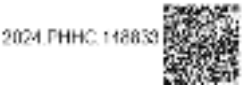
Per contra, learned State counsel while referring to the reply submitted by the State has not disputed the factual matrix and admitted the fact that alleged injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature.

In the meanwhile, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and co-operate in the same. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.”

4. Learned State counsel on telephonic instructions received from S.I. Rajinder Singh informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 16.10.2024 passed by this Court, interim

bail granted vide order dated 16.10.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.
7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
