This is an application under Section 151 of CPC moved by the respondents-State seeking to withdraw the impugned show cause notices.

For the detailed reasons set out in the application, which are duly supported by an affidavit, and particularly, as the prayer made therein is not opposed by learned counsel for the non-applicant/petitioner, the same is allowed. Consequently, the applicant/respondents are permitted to withdraw the show cause notices that have been assailed in the petition with liberty to issue afresh, if so advised.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of the order passed in CM-5103-CWP-2024, nothing substantive survives in the



petition and the same be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
