Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 and on instructions from ASI Sukhvinder Singh submits that there is some property dispute between the parties and in case any such representation submitted by the petitioner is pending, the same will be considered and decided by the competent authority as per law, at the earliest.
4. In light of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Additional Director General of Police (NRI), Punjab to consider and decide representation dated 26.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) having UID No.2408417, submitted by the petitioner, in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
