VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 05.09.2023 passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Sunam in Civil Suit No.CS-39-2016 dated 21.01.2016.

2. During the course of arguments, a consensus has arisen between learned counsel for the petitioner as well as respondent Nos.1 and 2 to the effect that the impugned order dated 05.09.2023 be sustained but the petitioner be granted liberty to lead rebuttal evidence to the additional evidence sought to be produced by respondent Nos.1 and 2 and that respondent Nos.1 and 2 would pay an amount of Rs.10,000/- as costs to the



petitioner on or before 30.08.2024, which is the date fixed before the trial Court.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances and the joint statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner as well as respondent Nos.1 and 2, the present revision petition is disposed of with the following observations:-

- i) Order dated 05.09.2023 is upheld and the petitioner is granted liberty to lead rebuttal evidence to the additional evidence sought to be produced by respondent Nos.1 and 2.
- ii) Respondent Nos.1 and 2 would deposit an amount of Rs.10,000/- as costs before the trial Court on or before 30.08.2024, which is stated to be the next date before the trial Court, and the trial Court is directed to release the said amount to the petitioner.

4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
