1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.42 dated 19.08.2024, registered under Sections 118(1), 118(2), 126(2), 351(2), 351(3), 191(3) and 190 of BNS, 2023 (Section 238 BNS added lateron), at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.
2. By virtue of order dated 19.09.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated. He further submits that the matter is also amicably settled as the FIR was lodged on the basis of misunderstanding between the parties and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
4. Learned counsel for the complainant has also affirmed the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner.
5. Learned State counsel has placed on record status report by

way of affidavit of Karnail Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Bholath Kapurthala. On instructions from SI Malkeet Singh, he has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 19.09.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
