Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 29.08.2024 (Annexure P-7), the petitioner has already joined and the only apprehension of the petitioner is that the said temporary duty will be extended even beyond 30.09.2024 for which the petitioner has already filed a detailed representation dated 27.08.2024 (Annexure P-6), hence, before passing any further order in pursuance to the order dated 29.08.2024 (Annexure P-7), the respondents should consider the representation of the petitioner dated 27.08.2024 (Annexure P-6).

On the asking of the Court, Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the period of temporary duty is to be extended beyond 30.09.2024, the

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
