Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has already been issued the gradation certificate and as one post in the category in which the petitioner was competing for Group-D post, has been kept vacant, the respondents are under obligation to consider the claim of the petitioner against the said post and pass an appropriate order.

Learned State counsel submits that the appropriate consideration to the claim of the petitioner will be given, qua the one post which has been kept vacant, by the competent authority, within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to him, otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim will be mentioned for the information and necessary action of the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
