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**AMARJOT BHATTI, J (Oral):**

1. Petitioner-Rekha has filed present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to provide police protection to her life and liberty and to direct respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere or cause any harm to the petitioner.

As per order dated 10.09.2024 respondent No.2 was directed to take appropriate measures to protect life and liberty of the petitioner considering the threat perceptions.

2. Today, status report has been filed by learned State counsel. As per status report, no police official visited the house of the petitioner nor she has been harassed in any manner. Earlier she was involved in FIR No.281 dated 06.05.2021 under Sections 20 and 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City, Rohtak. Now the police is conducting investigation in FIR No.328 dated 25.08.2024, Police Station Kalanaur, and in case during investigation her name figures out then the police will



take action as per law.

3.            At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the status report, present petition has rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of in view of the status report.
4.            Considering the aforesaid factual position detailed in the status report no further direction is required.
5.            Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
6.            Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
