1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.124 dated 01.08.2024, under Section 305 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana, Police Commissionerate.

2. Vide order dated 11.09.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 11.09.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and has appeared before the Mediation Centre as well. He further submits that the mediation also remained successful and the compromise deed has been made.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has submitted that though the petitioner has joined the investigation and the



compromise has also been effected between the parties before the Mediation Centre but the petitioner should be given time to honour the terms and conditions of the compromise deed and as such the present case be kept pending by adjourning the same to some short date.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmej Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

6. On hearing learned counsel for the parties, it is apparent that the petitioner has joined investigation and the mediation also remained successful. The compromise deed admittedly has been executed between the parties. Both the parties would remain bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise deed.

7. In view of the above, interim order dated 11.09.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

8. Petition stands allowed.
