KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. After addressing arguments for some time, when this Court was not inclined to grant the asked for relief, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the instant petition. However, he submits that a mandamus be passed upon the learned trial Court concerned to decide the regular bail application, if any, filed by the petitioner within two days.
2. Leave granted.

Consequently, the instant petition is **dismissed** as withdrawn with a direction to the learned trial Court concerned that in case the petitioner surrenders within 15 days from today and files an application for regular bail, the same shall be decided within two days thereafter by affording an adequate opportunity of hearing to the parties concerned.
