HARKESH MANUJA, J.(ORAL)

1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for alleged willful non-compliance of the order dated 26.02.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-7396-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Jitender Pal Singh, Chief Engineer, Headquarters, Department of Water Resources, Punjab, has been filed on behalf of respondent No.2. The same is taken on record.
3. As per compliance report, arrears of revision of pay already stand released in favour of petitioner, however, interest @ 6% for the delayed disbursal shall be calculated from the date of notification till the date of disbursement and the same will be released within a period of 4 weeks from today.
4. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage and submits that the same be disposed of with liberty to revive the same in case needful is not

done.



5. Ordered accordingly.
6. However, in case the needful is not done within the
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at
liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality, the
respondents would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs
from his own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses,
immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
6. Rule stands discharged.
