In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the father of the petitioner unfortunately died on 26.05.2022 while in service and the petitioner had raised a claim for the grant of compassionate appointment, which consideration is not being finalized and the same is causing prejudice to the petitioner, hence, respondents be directed to pass an appropriate order on the claim of the petitioner for the grant of compassionate appointment in a time bound manner.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Satnam Preet Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as per his instructions, the claim of the petitioner is under consideration and the



said consideration will be finalized within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the benefit as being claimed, the same will be granted to the petitioner, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
