1. Petitioners Neeraj Sharma and Arun Sharma have filed petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, seeking direction to official respondents to give advance notice in case petitioners are required to be detained in FIR No. 21 dated 22.03.2024, under Section 346 of IPC, registered at Police Station Banur, District Patiala, Punjab (Annexure P-1).

2. On the asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G. Punjab has appeared on behalf of State. Since advance copy of petition was already supplied to him, he informed that during investigation, concerned Investigating Officer had visited petitioners for recording their statements to know about whereabouts of missing girl. It is pointed out that Investigating Officer will follow proper procedure in case petitioners are required for any purpose in connection with investigation of aforesaid FIR.
