RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 16.01.2023 passed in LPA No.1632-2014.
2. Short reply dated 03.04.204 by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Singh Chahal, (IPS), Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Affidavit of Sandeep Rishi, IAS, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
4. Counsel for the respondents have submitted that status quo has been maintained by the respondents.
5. Otherwise also, for determining whether there is any violation of status quo order or not; a lot of disputed questions are required to be

decided. However, adjudication of the disputed questions of fact would not even be appropriate in the contempt proceedings. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

6. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to make any other prayer before the appropriate Court, but in accordance with law.
