KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for extension of furlough for four weeks to the petitioner, who is already on furlough granted by respondents no.1, for a period of 14 days, vide Release Warrant dated 15.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) under the provisions of Section 4 of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoner's (Temporary Release) Act, 1962, which was further extended for two weeks vide order dated 27.08.2024 (Annexure P-9), passed by this Court, on account of death of mother of the present petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the extension of furlough, already granted by this Court vide order (*supra*), has been sought on the ground that petitioner's father is critically unwell and, he

has been recommended by the doctor concerned to undergo a surgical intervention for the purpose of pacemaker implantation.

3. On 10.09.2024, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“While placing reliance upon Cardiology OPD Card (Annexure P-4/A), learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner's father requires to be implanted with a pacemaker. Therefore, through the instant petition, prayer has been made for extension of parole, which was granted till 13.09.2024, by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 27.08.2024.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Manish Bansal, P.P., UT, Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 and 2, and waives service.

He seeks time to file a status report in the instant matter.

Adjourned to 19.09.2024.

The prole as granted to the present petitioner, by this Court vide order dated 27.08.2024, is extended only till the next date of hearing.

4. Learned PP, UT, Chandigarh, though has not filed a status report, however, on instructions imparted to him by ASI Dilbar Sigh, he submit the the father of the petitioner requires a surgical intervention, and has produced in the Court the medical documents of the father of the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, the furlough as already granted to the present petitioner vide order dated 27.08.2024 (Annexure P-9), which was further extended vide aforesaid extracted order dated 10.09.2024, is now further extended for a period of three weeks from 20.09.2024 to 10.10.2024.

6. The petitioner shall re-step into the prison on dated 10.10.2024 by 05:00 p.m.

7. In case, petitioner fails to step back into the prison on the aforesaid date, the SHO concerned, shall arrest him and thereupon, send him to the concerned jail.
8. **Disposed of** accordingly.
9. All pending applications, if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
