SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner is aggrieved by the non-supply of information by the Public Information Officer, Deputy Commissioner, Moga, despite order dated 10.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) passed by the first appellate authority under the Right to Information Act, 2005.
2. The petitioner has remedy of second appeal against the impugned order, which he has not availed.
3. In case, second appeal is filed by the petitioner within a period of 15 (fifteen) working days from today, then the same shall be entertained and decided by the second appellate authority, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of one week thereafter.
4. Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
